#### **SAMOA - MOVING INTO THE FUTURE**

Samoa has recently passed legislation to move itself from one side of the international dateline to the other.

Currently located 32km to the east of the international dateline, Samoa will place itself to the west of the dateline by skipping one day this year. The move is intended to align Samoa with its major trading partners, being New Zealand, Australia and Asia, and make it significantly easier to do business with these countries.

Samoa will effect the change later this year when it skips Friday 30 December 2011.
